## Texas Children Recovering from Trauma

### An Initiative of the Department of State Health Services

Funded by: SAMHSA's National Child Traumatic Stress Initiative  
Grant No: 1U79SM061177-01; Funding Period Oct 2012-Sept 2016

- **AIM:** Transform community behavioral health services in Texas into a trauma-informed care system that fosters resilience and recovery.
- **Phase 2:** *TIC Organizational Transformation*

***Goal: Pilot TIC organizational transformation and implementation, support creating of statewide strategic plan and TIC Toolkit***



# Learning Collaborative Activities with NCBH

The following LC activities will be facilitated throughout the duration of this initiative :

- Three face to face Learning Community meetings
- Three individual team consultation calls
- Individual face to face meeting
- Four customized webinars (Based on high priority needs)
- Two Learning Community cohort calls
- Access to webinars focused on specific trauma-informed care domains (60-90 minutes)
- Access to vast array of tools and resources related to each domain

# Roles of Your Support Teams

- **National Council for Behavioral Health (NCBH)**
  - Provides all core training, expertise and technical assistance /consultation on Trauma Informed Care throughout the Learning Collaborative. “The Master Trainers”
  - Provide technical assistance and consultation to Transformation Teams and coordinate individual and group technical assistance calls
  - Coordinate all core webinar trainings
- **Texas Institute of Excellence in Mental Health (TIEMH)**
  - Be the primary point of contact for support to Transformation Teams and Pilot Sites throughout the Learning Collaborate
  - Coordinate special trainings and technical assistance as needed supplementing the National Council on Behavioral Health training and technical assistance. For example: Creating Family/Youth/Adult Client Voice, Secondary Traumatic Stress, Special Populations
  - Coordinate registration to all live-events and send notifications to Transformation Teams for all upcoming events
  - Evaluate Transformation Team efforts: gather, collect and analyze data.
  - Develop Trauma Informed Care Organizational Transformation Toolkit
- **Department of State Health Services (DSHS)**
  - Provides oversight to the TIC Transformation Learning Collaborative and all efforts.
  - Provide additional assistance as needed to pilot sites, TIEMH and NCBH
  - Provides additional resources and training opportunities through the National Child Traumatic Stress Network (NCTSN)

# Expectations

- Transformation Teams Members will participate in:
  - Live-trainings (3 in a year), webinars, consultation calls and local team meetings
  - Provide a presentation at the in-person meetings (updates)
- Each pilot site will establish at least three goals to foster TIC in their organization for the length of the learning community.
  - One of the goals must address Secondary Traumatic Stress in the workforce
- Complete assessment/evaluation tools

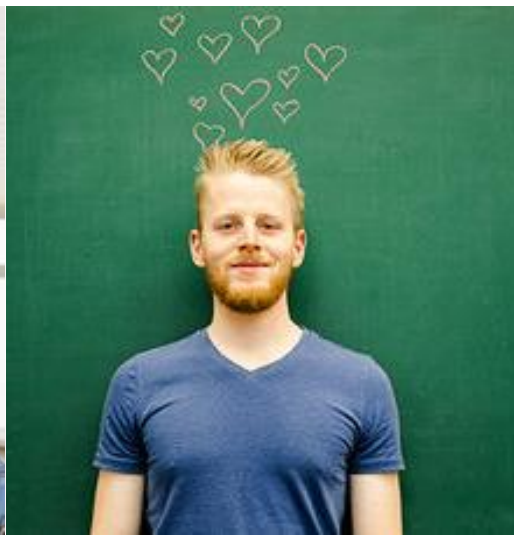
